How to quote an article apa in text

The referenced material must be played word for word. Always include the author's last name, year of publication, and page numbers. Use 'p.' for a single-page number (Example: p. 15) and 'pp.' for multi-page numbers (Example: p. 125-126). If you report an online source without page numbers, indicate the paragraph number (Example: paragraph 4). Author before offering with page numbers Author (Year) Offer (p. #). So if the name starts with a lowercase letter at the source you mention, as is the case above with the name lyoob, keep it lowercase. The exceptions to this are whether the name 1) begins a sentence or 2) is the first word after a colon, when what follows the colon is an independent term. From the second citation onwards, include only the name of the first author followed by et al. (and others). Sources with six or more authors are always shortened, including the first report. If the source uses headings, indicate the following heading and paragraph number. Large headings may be shortened, but they should then be enclosed in quotation marks. If the list comes from many different sources, add references to text after each list item. The information may be missing, confusing to the reader, or simply different. The most common exceptions are listed below. If the author is unknown, mention the first words in the reference list entry (usually the title). Enclose the title in double quotation marks when an article, Web page, or book chapter is listed. Italics for the title of magazines, books, exhibitions and brochures. Multiple sources in the same parentheses If you use multiple sources to support a sentence, you can combine references into text and separate them using semicolons. Order of sources alphabetically. If you use multiple sources from the same author, you do not have to repeat the author. Just add the other years and separate them with a comma. Several studies show that ... Multiple publications by the same author(s) in the same year To differentiate two publications from the same author published in the same year, add a adjective after the year of publication. Research by Swaen (2014a) shows that ... Repeated use of the same source To reference the same source multiple times in a paragraph there are specific APA guidelines. The first report should be the author and the year of publication. For subsequent references to the text that is running, you only need to include the author's last name, not the year. However, references to parentheses should always include the year. Research by Swaen (2016) shows that students believe the APA Report Generator is a useful tool. Swaen also reports that universities are increasingly using the generator. As a result, Scribbr continues to develop the Citation APA generator (Swaen, 2016). Different authors with the same last name To distinguish between two (or more) authors with the same last name, include the initials. This rule applies even if the year of publication is different. B. Swaen (2017) states that ... as does C. H. Swaen (2008). Reference a source within a source (secondary source) If you want to report a source you found to another source, you can do one of two things. First of all, you should try to find the original source (main source). If you are able to find it you can use the normal APA instructions. If you are not able to find the main source, you should report it through the source that led you to it (secondary source). The reference to text looks like this: Porter (as mentioned in Johnson, 2017) declares that... Note that you only need to include the year of publication of the source you consulted (here Johnson). Personal communication Personal communication, such as phone calls, emails, and conversations, is not listed in the report list because they cannot be found anywhere. However, you should report them using a reference to text. Provide the initials and surnames of the person you contacted and give as exact a date as possible. Sales decline in the second quarter (P. G. Brown, personal communication, June 13, 2018). FAQs When should I use et al. in references to APA text? Depending on the number of authors a source has, a reference to APA text is shortened using et al. (meaning others) after the first author's name. Sources with 3-5 authors are written in full the first time and shortened from the second citation onwards. Sources with 6+ authors are always shortened, even the first time.
